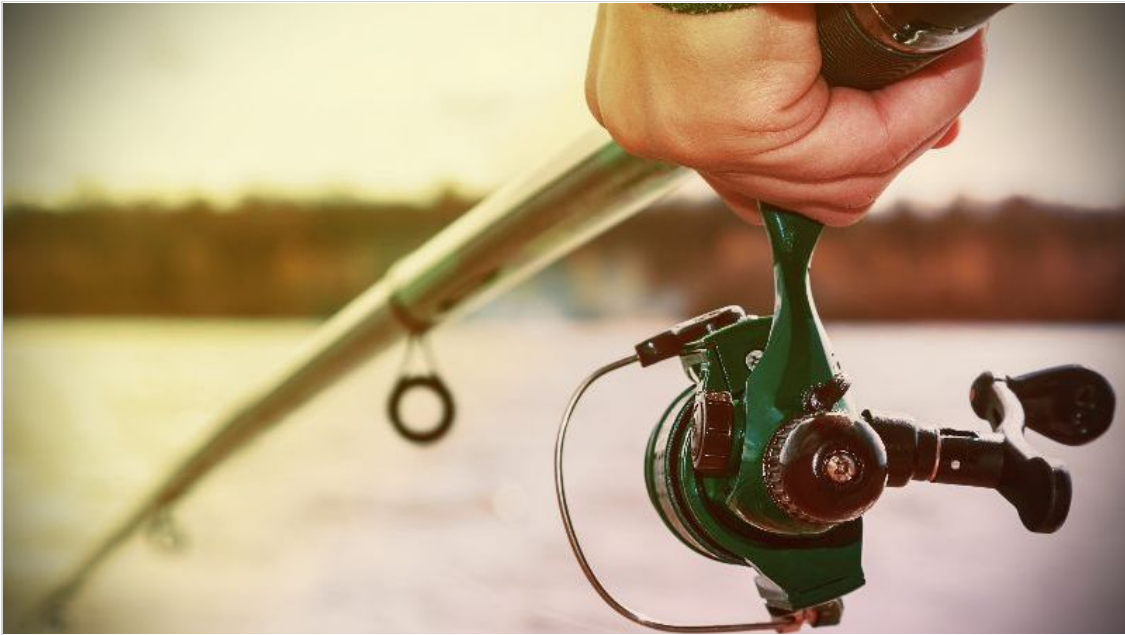

## Provider credentialing and licensing data affected by cyberattack

Maximus, a contractor of health data to the Ohio Department of Medicaid, recently notified the Department that Ohio provider credentialing and licensing data, including provider names, addresses, social security numbers and other information, may have been exposed on May 19, 2021 when an unauthorized entity gained access to an app.

On June 22, the *Dayton Daily News* reported that Maximus says it "promptly took the impacted information offline, launched an investigation with a leading cybersecurity firm, activated response protocols, and notified law enforcement." The *Dayton Daily News* article also said the company mailed letters to affected providers June 18 indicating that there was no evidence that the information has been misused. Maximus is offering 24 months of complimentary credit monitoring services.

## DODD Family ECHO

Family ECHO uses ZOOM technology to connect you with a team of interdisciplinary experts for presentation and discussion on topics related to improving and managing behaviors, family supports, executive function, self-care, and healthcare for children and youth with developmental disabilities including autism. Family ECHO follows the ECHO model offering an “all teach, all learn” environment and provides resources and session recordings for participants.

### Who can participate in Family ECHO:

- Parents, family members, and caregivers of individuals with autism and other developmental disabilities.
- Parents/professionals working in the disability field.
- Healthcare professionals working directly with families.

### Participants will:

- Earn certificates of attendance through this interactive, case-based learning series.
- Learn with interdisciplinary providers.
- Participate in a 60-minute session using a virtual platform.
- Review case vignette presentations and participate in interactive discussions and recommendations.

## **RTA announces next phase in effort to go cashless on all buses**

The Greater Dayton RTA will discontinue the sale of Day Passes onboard all buses beginning July 1 as part of the next phase of its plan to move to a cashless on-board fare system.

The RTA launched its new fare payment system, Tapp Pay, in June 2020. Tapp Pay is available via smartphones through the free Transit app, as well as reloadable smartcards. It is an account value-based payment system.

- Customers have value deducted from their account versus utilizing a pass.
- Customers can hold onto their money longer with Tapp Pay, and benefit from never paying more than the daily and monthly max fare rate.
- Customers are able to convert their cash into Tapp Pay value through a network of over 300 retail outlets located within close proximity of RTA bus routes.

- They may also use debit or credit cards to add funds to their account via the Transit app, payment kiosks, or website portal.
